“To The Test”

We test a lot of things, don't we? Maybe I should say a lot of things are tested for us, and the government is the biggest one of all. Agencies like the FDA, USDA, OSHA, NIST, EPA, NHTSA, NTSB, and the list goes on and on! I think the US consumes the most tested products in the history of the world, and you have to wonder why. Are our lives predicated on testing?

The fact of the matter is we can't get away from tests. Kids are now tested to see in which what grade they will start. My great-great nephew (no, I'm not that old) skipped kindergarten and was placed in the first grade because testing showed he was advanced in his learning beyond his age peers. Every year we are in school we are tested to determine if we know the content of the subject matter well enough to advance further on the academic continuum. If so, we advance for more testing.

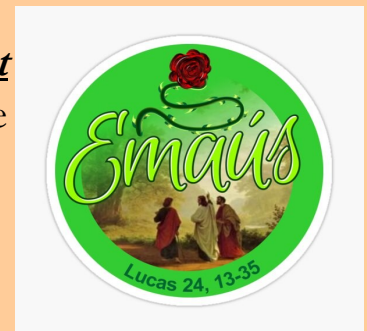


Methodist Men Breakfast

The Emmaus Men's & GALS Group is meeting the first and third Monday of each month in Classroom A. The next meeting will be Monday, January 19 at 8:30am.

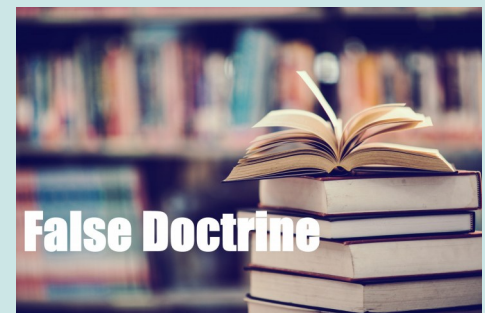

Boys & Girls Club Meal Sign-up for January

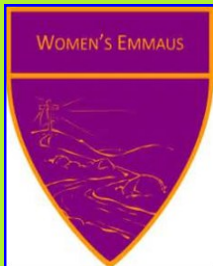

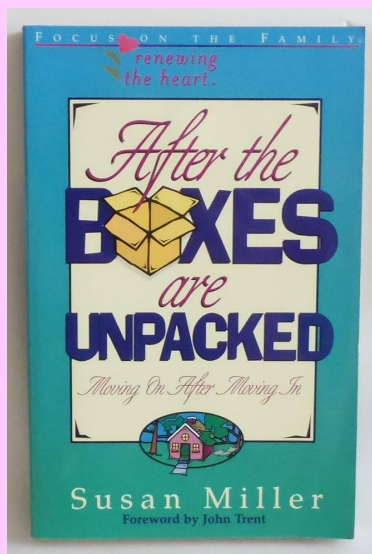
